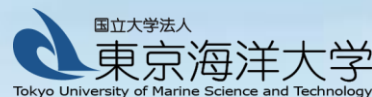

- Proposed to establish the “International Association of Marine-Related Institutions (IAMRI)” in 2004 by Meeting with Professor Sir William Wakeham, the Vice Chancellor of Southampton University;
- 7 founding members: University of Southampton, University of Bremen, University of Western Brittany, James Cook University, Pukyong National University, Tokyo University of Marine Science and Technology, Ocean University of China.

WHO WE ARE

- The First IAMRI General Meeting in Brittany France, July 2005
 - Adopted the "Constitution of IAMRI";
 - The IAMRI Secretariat placed at Ocean University of China;
 - Nominate Professor GUAN Huashi, President of OUC as the first Chairman of IAMRI.
- New Members joined in the network
 - Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution (2006);
 - Université du Québec à Rimouski (2007).

WHY IAMRI

How We Work

- The supreme authority of the IAMRI is vested in a General Meeting presided over by the Chairman;
- The chairmanship of the IAMRI rotates among its Steering Committee members. The Chairman serves for a term of two (2) years;
- The Secretary-General, Head of the secretariat, is to be nominated by the host institution of the Chairman and approved by the Steering Committee with a simple majority vote. The Secretary-General serves a term of two (2) years

 - 1+1+1 or 2+1 (one year at IAMR partner institutions)
 - Double Degree
