# Thinking & doing clean governance

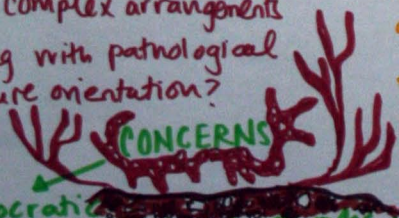
ways of thinking translate as ways of doing.

### HOW HAVE WE BEEN DOING GOVERNANCE?

- one size fits all. area-based tools eg MSP
- based on territorialising practices - based on land rules; conquer mentality
- draw stationary boundaries around moving elements
- in many cases, extension of colonial planning into the present.

- deciding; managing, controlling activities, people + resources
- complexity - various functions + players in complex arrangements
- How are we living with pathological earth with future orientation?
